Note 1 – Fares approved by Commission Decisions No. D.16-12-048 (Fares Between Tiburon and San Francisco), D.16-12-049 (Fares Between Angel Island and San Francisco) and D.16-12-0509 (Fares Between Sausalito and San Francisco), all issued on December 15, 2016.

Note 2 – For the San Francisco – Tiburon Service, a line item in prior Tariff filings listing a Commuters 20 tickets book for a price of \$140.00 has been deleted because the commuter hours service between Tiburon and the San Francisco Ferry Building will be provided by the Golden Gate Bridge Highway and Transportation District (“Golden Gate District”) from March 6, 2017 onwards instead of by Blue & Gold Fleet. Blue & Gold Fleet will honor on its ongoing midday service runs between Tiburon and San Francisco Pier 41 all unused discounted commuter tickets purchased from Blue & Gold Fleet prior to the date of takeover of the service by the Golden Gate District for 180 days from the date of takeover and also will refund the cost of unused tickets in prior purchased Commuters 20 ticket books when sent in for refund, with no expiration date for the refund program. The Golden Gate District has agreed to honor on its commuter hour service runs between Tiburon and San Francisco all unused discounted commuter tickets purchased from Blue & Gold Fleet prior to the date of takeover of the service by the Golden Gate District for 180 days from the date of takeover.

Note 3 – Angel Island fares do not reflect the current Angel Island entrance fees and franchise fees payable to the Angel Island State Park.

* Group fares applicable only on 15 or more adult and child fares combined. Tickets must be purchased at least 48 hours prior to the scheduled sailing on which the group will travel. Group tickets must be ordered and paid for as a single purchase, and no refund will be made for any unused group ticket or portion thereof after the trip begins. The entire group purchase is refundable only if cancellation and refund are accomplished at least 24 hours prior to the scheduled departure. Group Wholesale tickets are sold to large volume commercial enterprises such as tour group companies.
