Why am I receiving this notice?

On September 10, 2020, Blue & Gold Fleet, L.P. filed its applications with the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) for authorization to discontinue scheduled passenger transport service between San Francisco and Angel Island State Park and between San Francisco and Tiburon.

If the CPUC approves these applications, Blue & Gold Fleet, L.P. will stop all passenger transportation between San Francisco and Tiburon and transportation between San Francisco to Angel Island State Park.

Why is Blue & Gold Fleet, L.P. requesting to stop passenger service?

Ticket sales and revenues on passenger transportation service have been declining significantly over the last few years. At the same time, operating costs have risen significantly. Without discontinuing passenger transportation, Blue & Gold Fleet, L.P. would be operating at an increasingly significant operating loss.

How could this affect my transportation from San Francisco Angel Island State Park?

If Blue & Gold Fleet, L.P.'s request is approved by the CPUC, passenger transportation provided by Blue & Gold Fleet, L.P. will be discontinued.

How could this affect my transportation from San Francisco to Tiburon?

If Blue & Gold Fleet, L.P.'s request is approved by the CPUC, passenger transportation provided by Blue & Gold Fleet, L.P. will be discontinued.

How does the rest of this process work?

These applications will be assigned to a CPUC Administrative Law Judge who will consider proposals and evidence presented during the formal hearing process. The Administrative Law Judge will issue a proposed decision that may adopt [Utility]'s application, modify it, or deny it. Any CPUC Commissioner may sponsor an alternate decision with a different outcome. The proposed decision, and any alternate decisions, will be discussed and voted upon by the CPUC Commissioners at a public CPUC Voting Meeting.
